Rock cakes

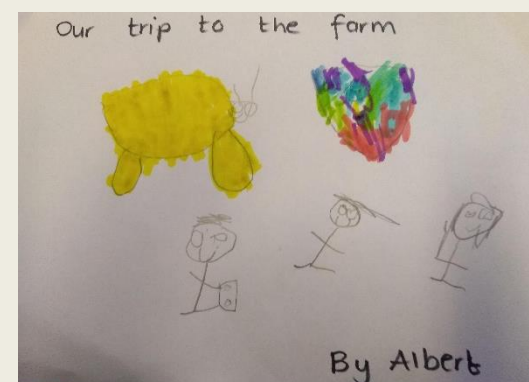
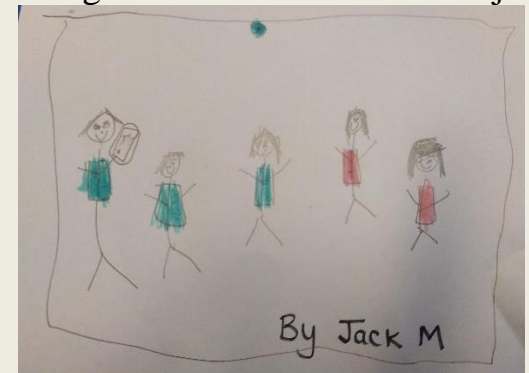
- 1 egg beaten

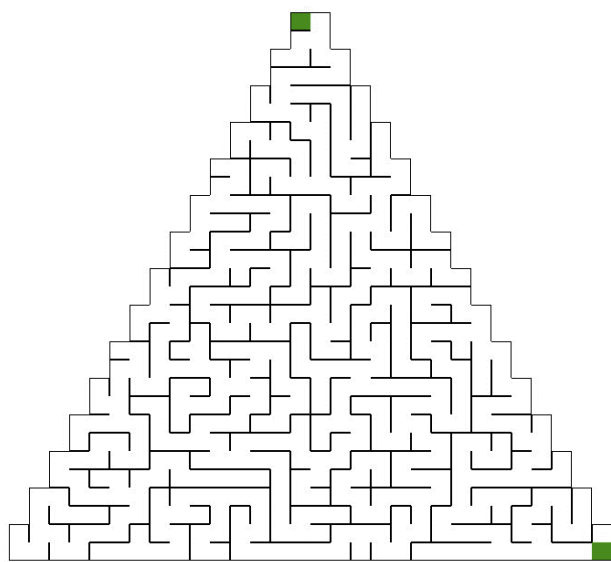
