The use of Grant Funding at Crickhowell Community Primary School

Here is some information about grant funding the school is in receipt of and how it is used.

Grant	Purpose	How it is being used in School
PDG -Pupil deprivation grant	The purpose of the grant is to allow FSM pupils to overcome barriers to learning to make progress.	£6,900 This money is used to pay support staff salaries to reduce group sizes for phonics and allow support staff to deliver ELSA provision for vulnerable learners.
EIG -Education Improvement Grant	The purpose of the Education Improvement Grant (EIG) is to improve educational outcomes for all learners by improving the quality of provision for learners.	£17,980 This money is used to pay support staff salaries, to ensure we can meet the needs of all learners. It is used to release staff for courses, monitoring, lesson observations and School development work.
PLG -Professional learning grant	The purpose of this grant is to allow schools to prepare for the new curriculum.	£5645 This money is used to release staff to read and report back on new curriculum guidance. It is used for release time to SDP priorities linked to new curriculum and whole school staff training.
